



VOCATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP

Huna Heritage Foundation (HHF) provides scholarships for Vocational Education and Apprenticeship programs to eligible applicants. To be funded, training should lead to gainful employment opportunities.

To be eligible applicants must:

- Be a Huna Totem shareholder or descendant.
- Need training to advance your career opportunities.
- Be accepted by or attending an accredited vocational training program.
- Provide proof of enrollment or letter of acceptance.
- Complete application fully and write your name at the bottom of each page
- Provide a copy of birth certificate. If the applicant is not a shareholder and applies as a descendant, the applicant must provide a photocopy of their birth certificate. If their grandparent is the shareholder, the applicant will also need to provide a copy of their parent's birth certificate.
- Submit all documents to verify you meet the above requirements.

Deadline Note:

Although vocational training applications are accepted on a continuous basis, application must be received in a timely manner to allow for trustee review/approval. Applications must be submitted at least two weeks before funds are needed.
